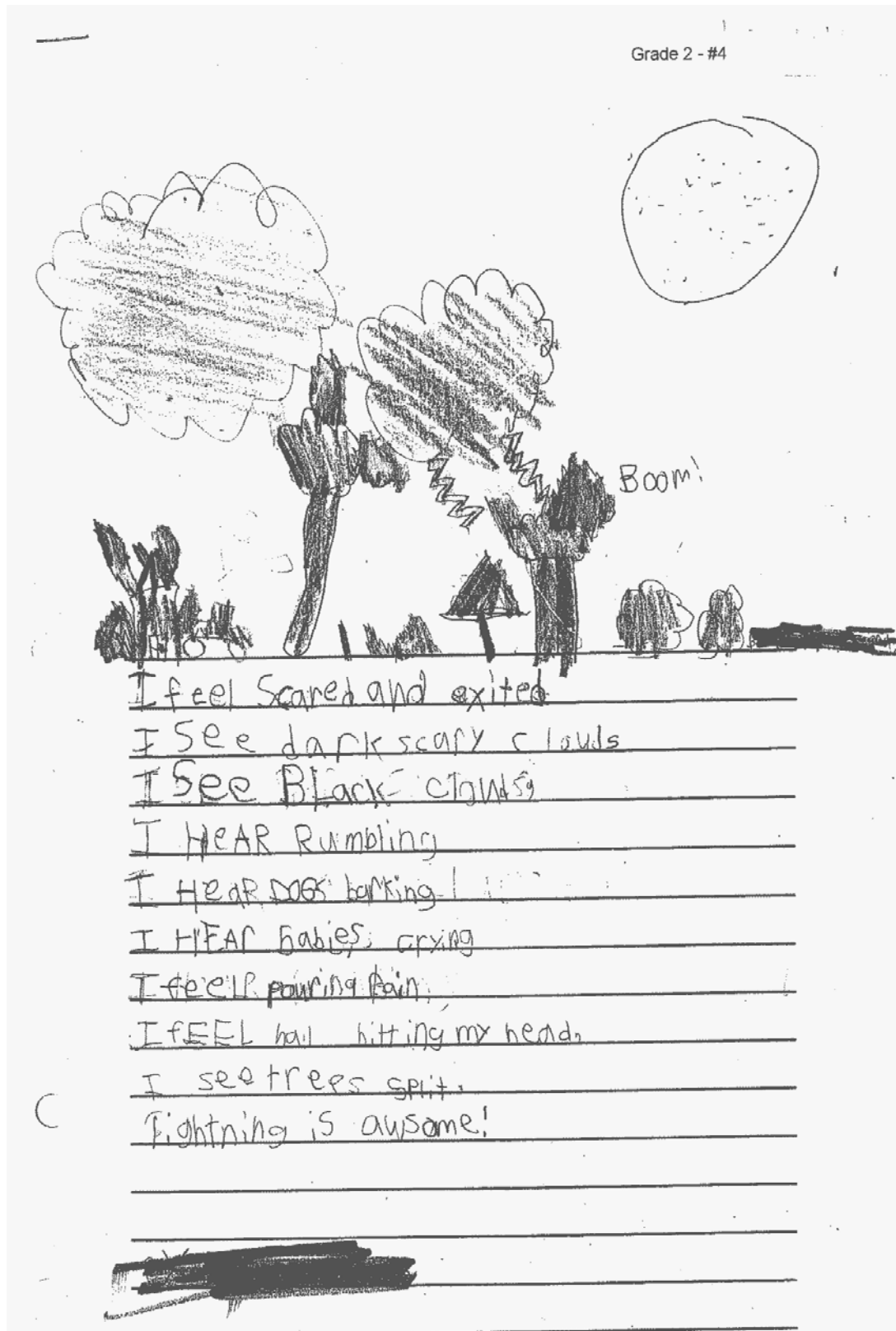

Something crazy is in every story.

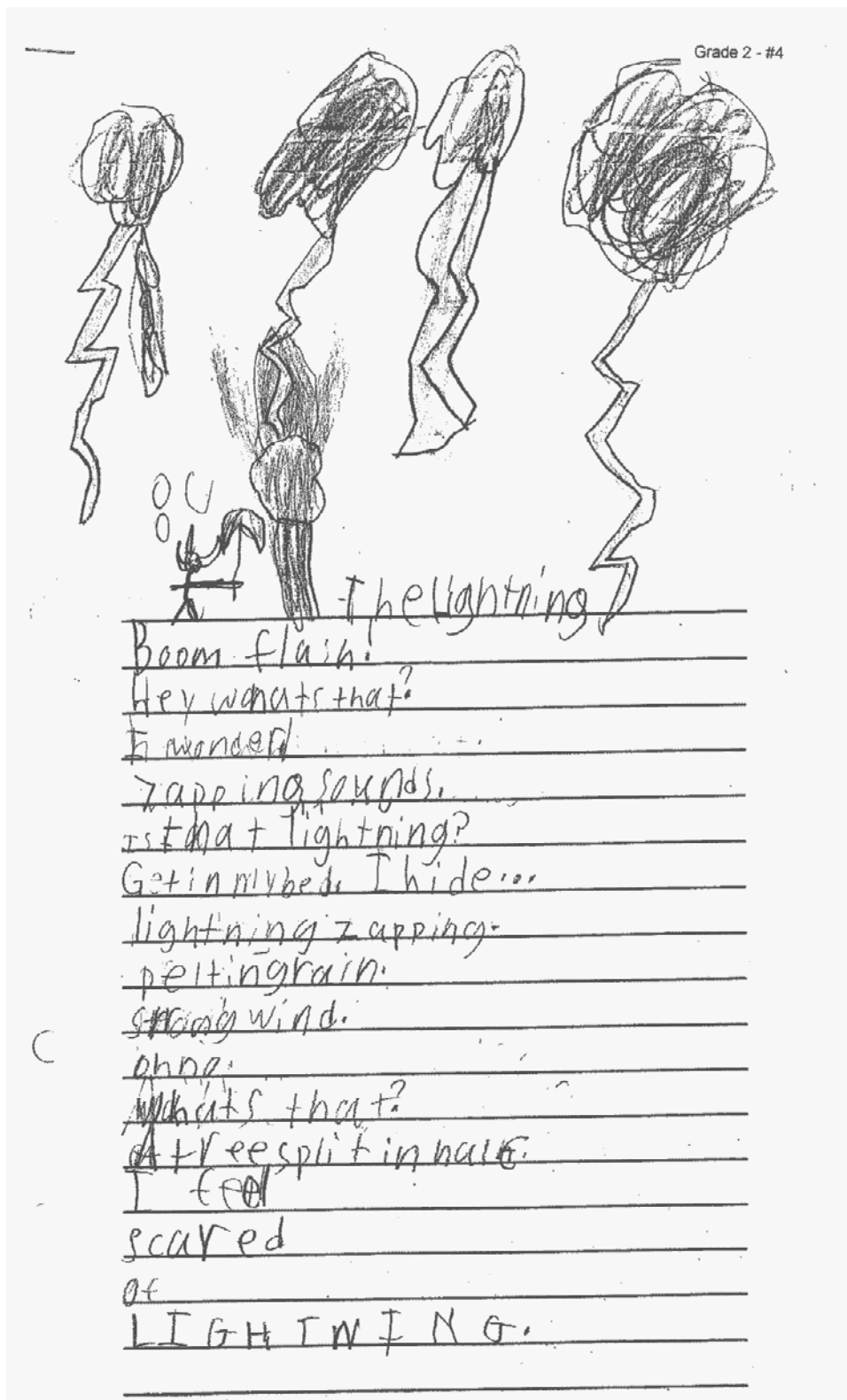

- weakness: simply developed ideas and organization

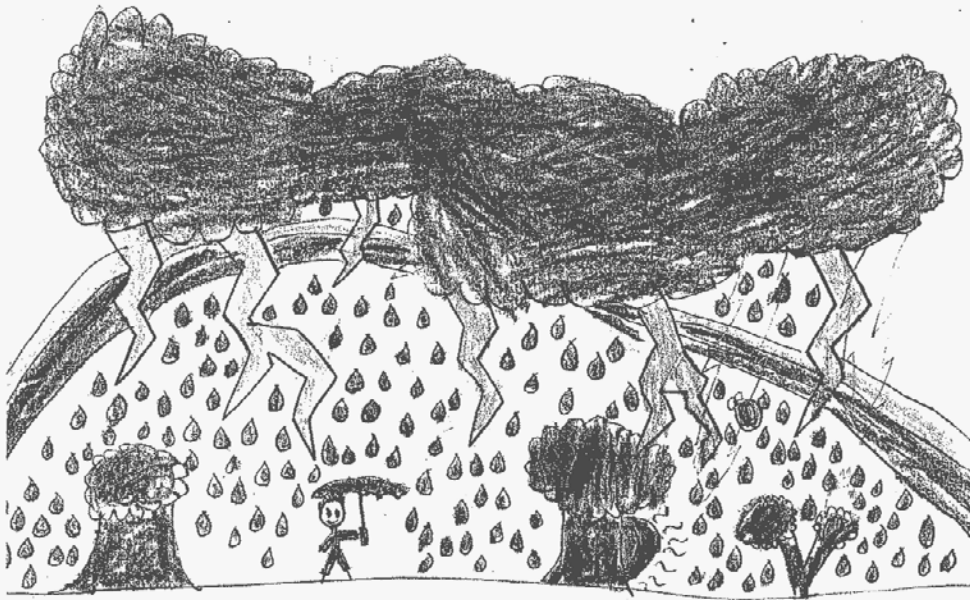

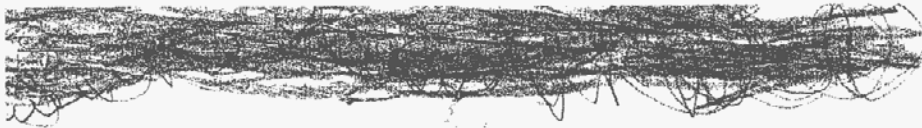
