They live in Australia, Borneo and in the mountains of New Guinea.

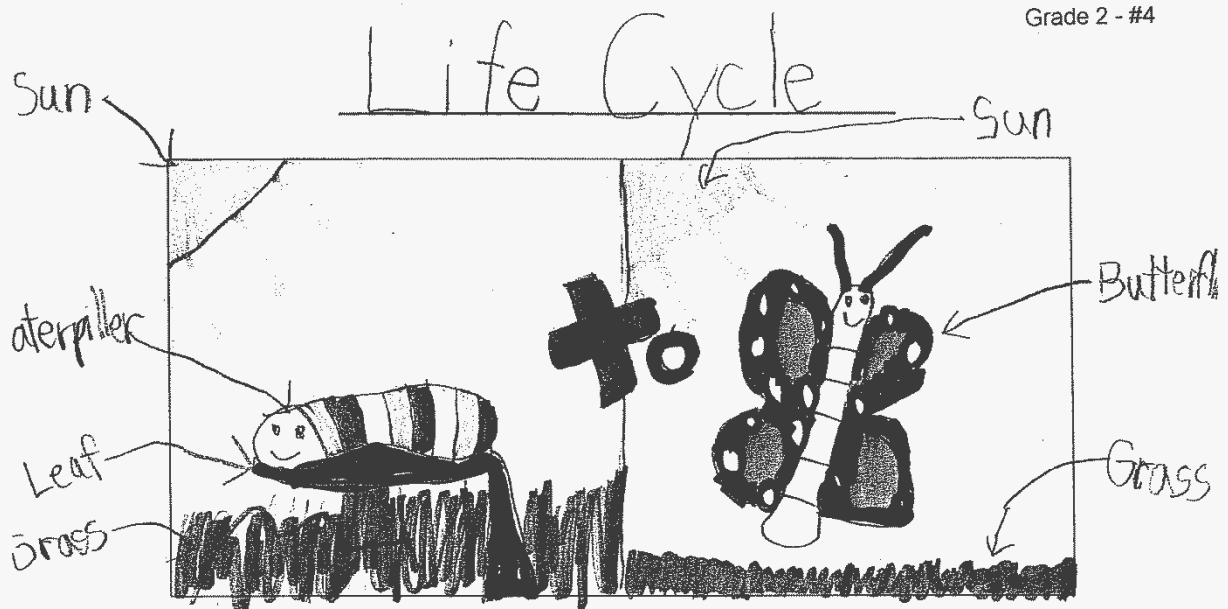
