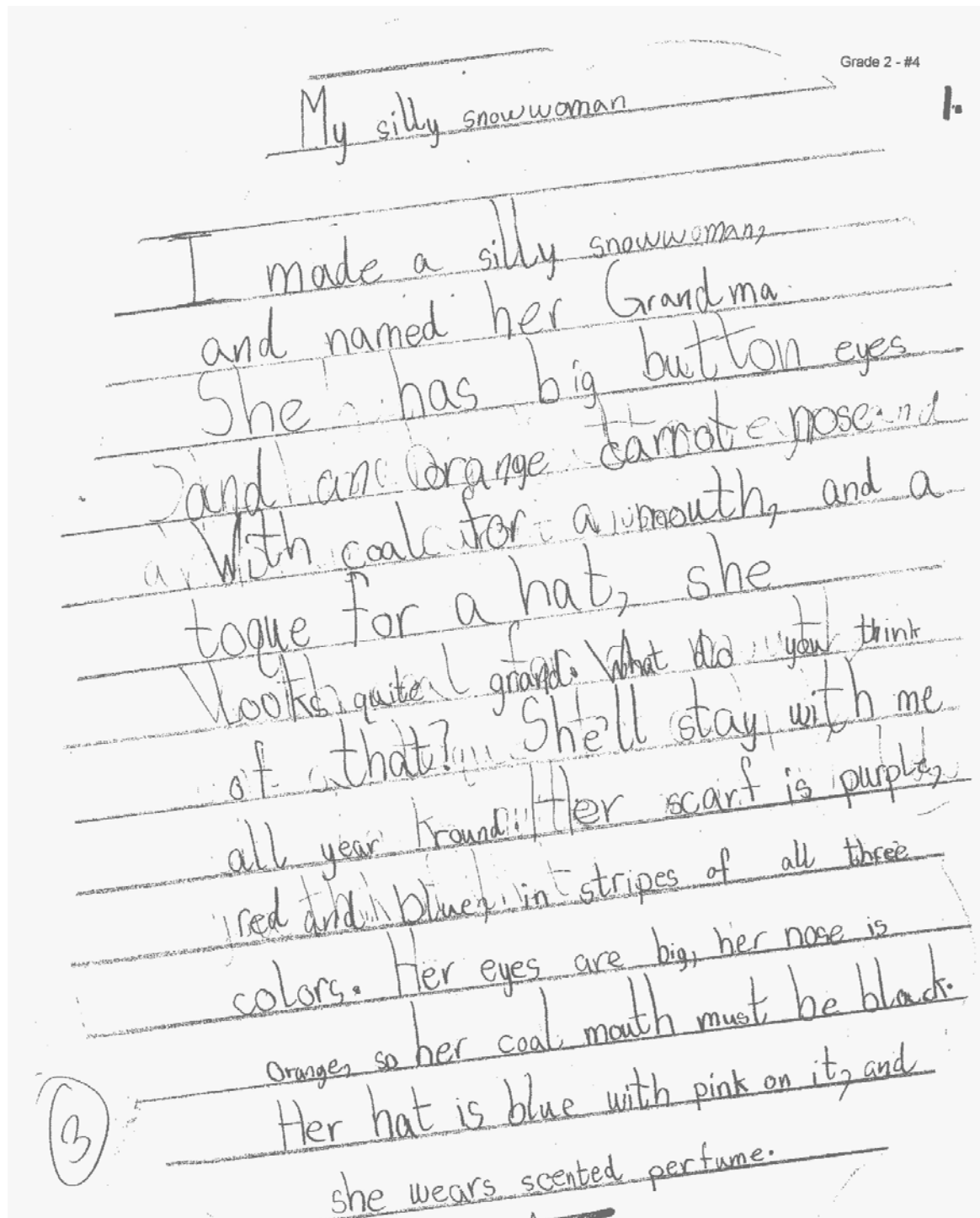
Dear People who read: My
