
- Start by selecting Browse by Grade or Browse by Subject, then select your curriculum or grade level from the dropdown menu.
- 2 Click on PDF to view the complete curriculum or click Online Format under Outcomes & Indicators in order to reference a specific portion of the curriculum.
- 3 Click on All Resources for This Curriculum to see the approved Core & Additional Resources to support this curriculum, plus Other Useful Materials for the classroom.
- 4 Core Resources are listed first, followed by Additional Resources, then Other Useful Materials. Definitions are provided for each classification of resource (e.g., What is a core resource?).











- 7 Click on the title of any item to see a pop-up of the detailed record. Anytime you see the Borrow from the STF Library link, click on it to see this item in the STF library catalogue. To request it, click the link at the bottom of the catalogue record. If available, it will be sent to your school, free of charge.
- 8 Under Quick Links on the curriculum home page, click on Teaching Tools and then on ROVER to search all of the videos available for streaming. ROVER also provides free access to the National Film Board's CAMPUS and to the CBC's Curio website, which now also includes videos from the National Geographic Channel.
- 9 Be sure to investigate other Quick Links. Under Teaching Tools, you will find links to free online Magazines, Journals and Newspapers. Under Truth and Reconciliation, you will find links to Supporting Reconciliation in Saskatchewan Schools as well as Treaty Education.
